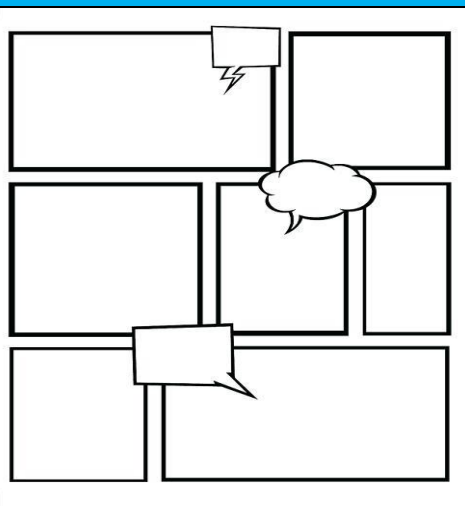

SECONDARY SCHOOL COMPETITION

To support the short story module in secondary schools, NESTA is pleased to announce this year's competition which will require students to practice their storytelling skills and creativity by designing a comic strip based on the theme of "Teen Pressures." The comic strip should have six to eight frames, use the elements of a short story and include images. It can be in black and white or color, and should be done by hand, not electronically.





Criteria

1. Open to forms 1 to 4 secondary school students.
2. Use the elements of a short story.
3. Relate to the theme of "Teen Pressures."
4. Have 6 to 8 comic strip frames.
5. Use images and words in the comic.

Judging Criteria

- ★ Use of elements of a story

- ★ Have 6 to 8 frames with images and words
- ★ Use of creativity

Prizes & Awards

1. Winner will receive \$500 book voucher from NESTA and publication in SCMP Young Post.
2. Graphic novels from Scholastic for runners-up.
